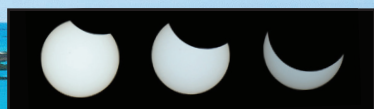


# W Australia Total Solar Eclipse



**April 13 - 24, 2023**

*An extraordinary eclipse adventure based near Exmouth at Bullara Cattle Station!*



**Dear Travelers:**

*We invite you to join our Total Solar Eclipse Adventure to Western Australia which will include accommodations at the 1/4 million acre Bullara Cattle Station to see the Total Solar Eclipse.*

*Our adventure will begin in Perth and Fremantle where we will learn about the aboriginal and European heritage in Western Australia. We'll also enjoy a Swan River Boat adventure to Rottnest Island and visit an historic Astronomical Observatory. At Yanchep National Park, just north of Perth, we'll look for Australian wildlife in the wild including koalas and kangaroos!*

*From Perth, we'll fly north about 1,000 miles to the Ningaloo/Exmouth area and Bullara Cattle Station. There will be opportunities to explore the superb Ningaloo Marine Reserve, to go snorkeling and diving, possibly with whale sharks.*

*We'll see the Total Solar Eclipse right on the Eclipse path! And celebrate with an Australian "barbie!"*

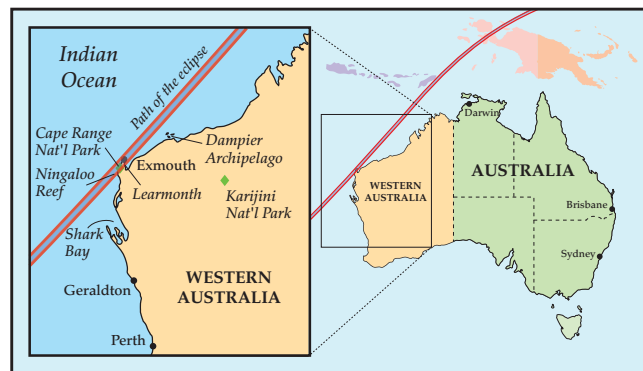
*At Bullara, enjoy yummy food from hot scones for breakfast to an Aussie "barbie!"*

## The Itinerary will include:

- Exploration of Perth and historic Fremantle, to learn about the aboriginal and European roots of Western Australia.
- First class accommodations in Perth, the premiere city in western Australia.
- A chance to see koalas, kangaroos, and other unique Australian critters in the wild.
- An all-day boating excursion to Rottnest Island for snorkeling, biking, and to look for the unique quokkas (short tailed wallabies).
- Four nights in comfortable glamping accommodations at Bullara Cattle Station beneath the amazing night skies of this vast desert wonderland.
- Snorkeling or diving amidst a profusion of tropical fish and possibly whale sharks in the Ningaloo World Heritage Marine Reserve.
- Learning about the history of the cattle station (first known as Punurrba or "Seabreeze" to the local Yingarrda people).
- Discovering the brilliance of the Milky Way and constellations in the southern night sky at a Dark Skies Star Party.
- Seeing the Total Solar Eclipse on April 20, 2023!



**What to Expect:** This expedition is planned for travelers who would enjoy seeing Western Australia and the Total Solar Eclipse plus having the lifetime opportunity to stay at a 1/4 million acre Australian cattle station. Also visit the city of Perth and historic Fremantle. Have comfortable glamping accommodations with electricity at Bullara Cattle Station, with B



and L at their cafe, and BBQ dinners by the fire or dinner purchased from food trucks. (Really! This is how they do it!). There are share

bathroom and toilet facilities. The cattle station is authentic and rustic and full of camaraderie!

Also enjoy snorkeling, optional scuba diving (added costs), exploring desert canyons, beach walks, and discovering the Milky Way at full blaze in the dark night skies. With leadership by an excellent naturalist plus local guides, it will be an exceptional experience. Weather will be warm to hot and sunny with almost perfect probability of seeing the Total Solar Eclipse. We invite travelers with a sense of adventure to join us. (No smoking in vehicles, during lectures, or meals, please.)

**W. Australia Trip Fee:** \$8,495 per person twin share plus air fare Los Angeles/Sydney/Perth, round trip \$1,995 + \$1,495 in-tour air Perth/Learmonth, RT. Singles are encouraged to book twin share. Six singles are available for \$2,495 additional.

**Expedition Fee Includes:** Group transfers, land transport, accommodations twin share in a first class hotel in Perth and glamping tents at Bullara Cattle Station; 4 breakfasts, 4 lunches, and 4 dinners; tips to drivers and local guides; entrance fees; leadership by an excellent Betchart naturalist; administration.

**Fee Does Not Include:** International air fare and in-tour air fare (quoted separately); airline checked bag fees; independent transfers; some meals; gratuities to expedition leaders; diving, whale shark or other optional excursions; personal items such as visa, laundry, bottled water or sodas, or other beverages at meals; alcoholic beverages, snacks; internet use, personal insurance, or other personal expenses.

**Deposit:** \$1,000 per person; final payment is due 150 days before departure (November 1, 2022).

**Cancellation Penalty:** Deposit is refundable less \$250 per person until 150 days before departure. Within 150 days of departure, payments are nonrefundable. Trip cancellation insurance will be offered.
